



Week One – Origins of the Bible

1) Welcome

2) Setting the premise:

Information not to defend your position, but to give a right answer:

- KJV: 1 Peter 3:15: But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts; and be ready always to give an answer to **every man that asketh you a reason of the hope** that is in you with meekness and fear.
- KJV: Col 4:6: Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that **ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.**
- KJV: Rev 5:1: And I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the throne a **book written within** and on the backside, sealed with seven seals.

The Bible is a Deeply Political Book

- It is the product of its time and bears the marks of its making
- The making of the King James Bible
- God Secretaries by Adam Nicolson

David is the product of the following references:

- King James: Thomas Chain Reference
- Amplified Bible
- Strong's Concordance
- Revelations from Spirit

3) Pre-Bible:

- In the Palaeolithic period, for example, when agriculture was developing, the cult of the Mother Goddess expressed a sense that the fertility which was transforming human life was actually sacred.
- Artist carved those statues depicting her as a naked, pregnant woman - which archaeologists have found all over Europe, the Middle East and India.
- Called Inanna in Sumeria, Ishtar in Babylon, Anath in Canaan, Isis in Egypt and Aphrodite in Greece.
- If men and woman "initiated the actions of the gods", they would share to some degree their power and effectiveness.
- Christianity was legalized in 313 A.D.

4) The First Bibles:

- **1380's:** The first hand written English language bible manuscripts was by **John Wycliffe** an oxford professor. (Translated from Latin)
- **1530's: William Tyndale:** First person who PRINT the New Testament.
- **1560:** The **Geneva bible** is the 1st bible to print both Old and New Testaments. It also added number verses to the chapters and reference numbers. Every chapter was accompanied by extensive marginal notes and references making the Geneva bible the 1st study bible. Shakespeare quotes the Geneva Bible in many of his plays. It was the first bible taken to America.

- **1580's:** The Roman Catholic Church saw it had lost the battle to keep the translation of the bible in Latin only and decided the bible was available in English, they would at least have an official **Roman Catholic English translation**.
- **1604: Protestant** clergy preceded King James desired new translation - replaced the Bishop Bible – anti-pope.
- **1611: King James** translators produced the New Testament and did a little more than copy out of the work of William Tyndale. They did not want marginal notations. Took seven years to put together.

5) Jacobean Era

- The period during which KJV was written was held in the grip of an immense struggle between the demands for freedom of the individual conscience and the need for order and imposed inheritance, between monarchy and democracy – extremism and toleration.
- Reformers: Purpose was to “dethroned the pope and enthroned the bible.” (50 Men)
- Purpose - to connect the Kingdom of God with godliness of KING'S and to make royal power and divine glory into one indivisible garment which could be wrapped around the nation as a whole.
- Bible scholars wrote Genesis and Exodus in the 8th century.
- The King James Version bible did not spring from the soil of Jacobean England as quietly and miraculously as a lily.
- There were: 1. arguments, 2. struggles, 3. exclusion, 4 .competitiveness

Law - Moses Grace - Truth

- **John 1:17** King James Version
 - For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.
- **Romans 8:2** King James Version
 - For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Two Commands Hold All The Law

- **Matthew 22:37-40** King James Version
- 37. Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.
- 38. This is the first and great commandment.
- 39. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself.
- 40. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

The Grace Of Law

Galatians 3:23-26 King James Version

- 23. But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should after-wards be revealed.
- 24. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
- 25. But after that faith is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster.
- 26. For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus.

3) Understanding Sin

Romans 6:14 King James Version

- For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace.
- Course In Miracles: "Into this empty space from which the goal of sin has been removed, is heaven free to be remembered."

Greek Translation – (Sin)

- Sin-Hamartia - (ha-mar-te'-a) - **to miss the mark**
- Mark-Chargma - (khar'-ag-mah) – **Character/Nature**

4) Meaning of Heaven

- **Heaven can mean:** Sky, Atmosphere, Outer space. The dominion of sun, stars, moon, etc
- **Psalm 104:12 Amplified**
 - Beside them the birds of the heavens have their nests; they sing among the branches.
- **Deuteronomy 4:19 King James Version**
 - And lest thou lift up thine eyes unto heaven, and when thou seest the sun, and the moon, and the stars, even all the host of heaven
- **Heaven from New Testament Word: (Greek) “ouranos”**
 - Singular or plural pronounced ou'-ran-os'.
 - Means elevation, happiness, power, sky
 - Also from Hebrew Word: Or'os: Meaning to rise, hill, mountain
 - Also from Hebrew Word: oh'ee-ra: Meaning to raise, suspense of the mind, remove (sin – take away)
Expiate Sin – **To atone, make amends.**

2 Corinthians 5:1 King James Version

- For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heaven.

Revelation 20:6 King James Version

- 6. Blessed and holy *is* he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.
- Resurrection - definition - Anastasis (*uh-nas-tuh-sis*) standing up again, raised to life again, and recovery of spiritual truth.
- The word “first” comes from the Greek word *protos pro'-tos* – meaning “foremost” in time, place or order. (from the root word meaning superior).

3) What is the Resurrection?

- The recovery of truth
- 1st resurrection are for those who attain truth while yet in the physical body.
- Raising of the mind
- Recover = Re” means again
- Jesus said “ I am the Resurrection”
- Resurrection is NOT somewhere

4) I Corinthians 15:35-44 King James Version

- 35. But someone will say, “How are the dead raised up? And with what body do they come?”
- 36. Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies.
- 37. And what you sow, you do not sow that body that shall be, but mere grain—perhaps wheat or some other *grain*.
- 38. But God gives it a body as He pleases, and to each seed its own body.
- 39. All flesh is not the same flesh, but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of animals, another of fish, and another of birds.
- 40. There are also celestial bodies and terrestrial bodies; but the glory of the celestial is one, and the glory of the terrestrial is another.
- 41. There is one glory of the sun, another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for one star differs from another star in glory.
- 42. So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption.
- 43. It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.
- 44. It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

5) John 5:28-30

King James Version

- 28. Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice.
 - 29. and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of damnation.
 - 30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.
- ⤴ Graves – hear His Voice – come forth damnation
 - ⤴ Evil - Good
 - ⤴ Grave – root word - mimnesko (*mim-nace'-ko*) to remind, to recall to mind:--be mindful, remembrance.
 - ⤴ Another form of the word in Greek is mnaomai (*mnao'-om-ahee*) means a fixture in the mind, mental grasp or to remember. To recover all that is stored in the memory of the Christ mind, but has been forgotten by the individual mind.
 - ⤴ Grave is the realm of lost truth, “The darkened mind “ (Dark side of the soul)
 - ⤴ Hear - To Understand
 - ⤴ Voice - Language of Tone
 - ⤴ Good – Intrinsic, the characteristic of the material itself, the essential nature and not the contents of any impurities it contains.
 - ⤴ Damnation - Greek (Krisis) meaning correction
 - ⤴ Evil – Foul, to clog or obstruct with a foreign substance, to disrespect
 - ⤴ Flaw – which is a hidden defect that may cause failure under stress or weakness.
 - ⤴ Within each of us is good and evil. The only thing that brings evil is to manifest and dwelling on the foreign substance.

John 3:30 King James Version - He must increase, but I *must* decrease.

- Jesus learned how to re-pattern the molecular structure of his body by raising the vibratory frequency of his cells. Hence “**The Resurrection**”.
- Dwell on Christ Consciousness
- You will decrease and the Christ consciousness will increase

Week Four – What Does Hinder Thee – Reality vs. Unreality

2) Reality vs. Unreality

Galatians 5:7 KJV

- “Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?”
- Ignorance is the greatest enemy of man. It is the cause of poverty, famines, disease and the dark conditions of the world. Yet, we repeatedly blame God for this. Why? We forget God placed the power to create within his creation - man. It is man, with this creative ability and free will, who is responsible for the conditions of the world. He produces, or creates, from the level of consciousness that he has acquired. It is his God-given ability.
- God’s will shall be done in the earth as it is in the heavens. This won’t be accomplished through robots, void of the freedom of choice, but through people who transcend human consciousness. This will be accomplished through people who awaken to a God consciousness with the ability to recreate a world of peace and harmony.

3) The Realm of Appearance

I Thessalonians 5:22 - Abstain from all *appearance* of evil.”

- *The word appearance means outward aspect, external show, view or form.*
- *The word evil comes from the Greek word poneros (pon-ay-ros) meaning hurtful, diseased, guilt, devil and sinners - all of these are referred to as being an appearance.*
- What an amazing thought! The things that create pain and grief are only appearances! They are not a part of our reality. Our belief in evil is a belief in an appearance. We have been programmed to believe evil is reality and the opposite of good-- remember “evil” is “live” spelled backwards. Evil belongs in the realm of appearance and is not a part of the realm of reality.
God is omnipresent and there is no other. God is not at war with the devil or anything else. It is only man’s thoughts that create an appearance of the devil. From His right hand are eternal pleasures and from His left hand are the songs of love, which guide the evolving soul.
- What is the night of the mind that creates the appearance of evil?

Psalm 139:12 “Yea the darkness hideth not from thee, but the night shineth as the day, the darkness and the light are both alike to thee .

- Treat people as they are to become, in the light of knowledge and understanding, and they will become whole and complete -- not according to the standards of the world, but according to God’s standards.

John 7:24" Judge not according to appearance, but judge righteous judgment."

- I once held a picture of a landscape before an audience, pointed to part of it and asked what it was. The response was: it was a tree. I asked the person who identified it as a tree to pick a leaf from the tree and give it to me. The mind was shocked from *appearance to reality*. The *appearance* was that of a tree, but the *reality* was, it was only a picture, or image, of a tree. The mind usually does not perceive things in reality, but judges things to be real according to how they appear externally. As the spirit overshadows the thoughts of the mind, which judge externally and by appearances, all thoughts transmute into a higher order. As you leave the realm of appearance, evil takes on a different form. It is not seen as wicked and sinful; but is recognized as an *undeveloped good*. We need to re-educate ourselves-- to give love, patience, and understanding freely to the world. We need to develop our good, allowing our eyes to see beyond the realm of appearances and into the heart, or true essence, of all.

I Samuel 16:7 “The Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance, but the Lord looketh on the heart

II Corinthians 4:18 “While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen {are} temporal; but the things which are not seen {are} eternal.”

- Webster defines *illusion* as *perception of something existing in such a way as to cause **misinterpretation** of its actual nature.*
- The answer to the question, “what does hinder thee?” lies in the conscious awareness that our true essence is merely separated by the illusions and appearances of humanity. When we see in the eternal realm, we deny separation. We live in the *eternal* true essence of our beings. When Jesus spoke of “this world”, he spoke of the physical, and external, temporal realm of existence. Because the material sense of the universe is an illusion
- God told Abraham to look at the sky and see the multitudes of stars as God's seed, which would come through Abraham's loins. Had Abraham judged things by appearances and not by the reality of the word of God, those words would never have been fulfilled. Abraham looked at those stars and called things which were not as though they were. By the faith of God, he became the father of many nations. Past the realm of appearance there is great potential for manifestation.

4) Awakening From the Dream

II Corinthians 5: 16 "Wherefore, henceforth, know we no man after the *flesh*..."

- The word *flesh* comes from the Greek word *sarx*, meaning *the body, symbol of what is external, human nature, carnally minded.*

Romans 8:6 "For to be *carnally minded* is death."

- The word *carnally* comes from the same Greek word as *flesh*. We have thought of the carnal mind as something unclean, wicked, evil, and lustful. This is a religious interpretation. The carnal mind is simply a mind that is affected by the external, physical realm of body consciousness. *Flesh* and the carnal mind are symbols of the external. To live in this consciousness brings death. Webster gives an interesting definition of death: "the *lie* of life in *matter*."
- We are already a spiritual spirit; we are becoming a spiritual mind that we may become a spiritual body.

Isaiah 26:19 "Awake and sing ye that dwell in dust .

Isaiah 52:1,2 "Awake, awake, put on strength, O Zion put on thy beautiful garments... Shake thyself from the dust, Arise..."

- The word *awake* comes from the Hebrew word *quwts*, which means *to arise, spend the harvest season*. It is not by accident that we entered this world, lost all memory of the spiritual realm and became subject to the illusions of the external realm. For an appointed season, we make our journey through the realm of appearances, through humanity. Our Harvest time has come; *awake!* We awaken to the light that we are. Romans' speaks of our slumber and our return to our "armor of light":

Romans 13:11,12

- "Knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake from sleep, for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand, let us, therefore cast off the works of the darkness and let us put on the armor of light."

- The word *awake* in this scripture is from the Greek word *egeiro*, meaning *to collect your faculties, awake from disease, death, nonexistence and ruin*. This scripture confirms death and disease are but a dream, an illusion, an appearance.
- When I was a child, we played a game that held you as prisoner inside chalk marks until someone tagged you and you were set free. One day, the other children decided to play a trick on me. They slipped away to go home, leaving me in my box, waiting to be tagged. I waited a long time and no one came. I didn't want anyone to think that I couldn't play the game, so I stayed inside the chalk marks. Soon, it started to get dark and I was hungry. Still no one came to free me. After awhile, I began to think, "I don't want to play this silly game anymore." So I simply stepped across the chalk marks that had confined me and went home. Those chalk marks are representative of the doctor's diagnoses; all symptoms, feelings of hurt, anger, bitterness and disappointment. When we tire of the game of life enough, we stop playing by its rules. As we awaken, we find that nothing has been holding us prisoner except the games of the world.

5) What does hinder thee?

- Learn to step out! Know that you are not bound by the rules of this world! This is the day of salvation. We can move out of all nightmares, all chalk marks, appearances and illusions into the reality of Christ.

Psalm 17:15 "As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness. I shall be satisfied when I awake, with thy likeness."

- We know there is only one thing that will ever satisfy us, and we will not compromise with anyone or anything that will hinder our journey.

Beyond Thinking - Ephesians 3:19-20 Amplified

- "That you may come to **know**, practically--through experience for yourselves-- the love of Christ, **which far surpasses mere knowledge** without experience, that you may be filled through all your being, unto **all** the fullness of God, that is, have the richest measure of divine presence and become a **body** wholly filled and flooded with **God Himself!** Now to him who by the action **of His power** that is at work **within** us, is able to carry out **His purpose** and do superabundantly, far over and above **all that we dare ask or think--** infinitely beyond our highest **prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams."**

Philippians 4:11-12 (NASB)

- "Not that I speak from want, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstance I am in. I know how to get along with humble means, I also know how live in prosperity. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the **secret of being**, filled and going hungry, both of having abundance and suffering need."

Week Five – Hell Yes? Hell No?

1) Welcome – Introduction

God's "Judgment" is the gift of correction he bestowed on all your errors, freeing you from them, and all the efforts they seem to cause.

- The word hell in the old testament is always a translation of the Hebrew word: "Sheol" (the place of the dead)
- Sheol translated 64x, hell 32x, grace 29x, pit 3x
- Hades, Tartarus, Gehenna words in the New Testament Greek are (incorrectly) translated "Hell"
- The word "Hades" in the Greek has the same definition as the Hebrew word "Sheol" the unseen, and all the above explanation applies.
- The word "Tartarus" is used only once in the bible, and refers to the deepest abyss of hades. So the definition of "Tartarus" is essentially the same as hades or Sheol.
- Notice the words Sheol, Hades, and Tartarus have nothing to do with burning. They all refer to what happens to a person's soul when he dies –the person's ability to use the five senses just ceases to exist. It is in the unseen.
- The meaning of the word "Gehenna": In the time Jesus, "Gehenna was a ravine just below Jerusalem, the valley of Hinnom, where the waste, refuse, garbage of the entrails of a butchered animal. Gehenna was the local garbage dump where the refuse was collected and burned. A fire burned continuously in Gehenna.

2) Go into Perfection

Therefore leaving the principle of the doctrines of Christ let us go to perfection.

Hebrew 6:1-2 –

1.. Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on, unto perfection. Not laying again the foundation of repentance from the dead works, and of faith toward God.

2. Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and the eternal (aion or chrenos) judgment.

- The word eternal "aion" (a-hee-ohn) means an age. Word "chrenos" means a passage of time.

From Dante's Inferno.

- First circle (Limbo) Second circle (lust) Third circle (gluttony) Fourth circle (greed) Fifth circle (anger)
- Sixth circle (heresy) Seventh circle (violence) Eighth circle (fraud) Ninth circle (treachery)

3) A Whole Different Gospel

John 5:27-29 KJV.

- 27. And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- 28. Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,
- 29. And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.
 - Damnation original word was – Condemnation (mis-alignment). Damnation meaning is the state of being excluded from God's mercy, and condemned to the everlasting punishment of the wicked.
 - When man is separated from the knowledge of who he is (the child of God) and is governed by religious laws of good and evil, the life flow of God is obstructed by the impurities he sees.
 - Damnation does not mean a final, eternal destiny of punishment and separation from God, but speaks of a process that will bring change.

Matthew 10:28 KJV

And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

- The word destroy - root word (**apollumi** : from “apo” which means to separate: destroy our union with the Divine in our mind)
- Short Definition: destroy, lose, am perishing

4) The Lake of Fire

▪ **Revelations 20:14 KJV**

And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death..

Aramaic - in plain English - And Death and Sheol were cast into The Lake of Fire-this which is the second death.

- Religion has long referred to hell as being an unending lake of fire. Hell is not a lake of fire. If Hell were such a lake, it certainly could not be cast into itself. The word lake comes from the Greek word *limne*, meaning the idea of the nearness of the shore. A lake is a limited body of water or space.
- The word fire comes from the Greek word *pur*, which means lightning, or the discharge of atmospheric electricity accompanied by a vivid flash of light .Out of the concept of fire as lightning, we can now view the judgments of God as being light or truth. The human race has not experienced freedom because truth has not been taught. Another form of the word *pur*, from which the word fire was taken, is *puroo*, also meaning to refine. Jesus made two interesting statements concerning the subject fire.

Luke 12:49 KJV - I am come to send fire on the earth.

Mark 9:49 KJV - Everyone shall be salted with fire.

- Another word associated with fire is brimstone comes from the Greek word (*theion*) meaning God-like, divine, and the Godhead. Both of the words fire and brimstone come from the root word (*theos*) meaning the supreme divinity of God. We have feared the words fire and brimstone because religion has used this pattern of fear to hold man in bondage. The dawning of a NEW DAY begins as the mind is freed from the chains of religious bondage. We no longer serve God out of fear but out of a new found reverence and respect. God does not deliver any man to hell. Whatever a man sows that shall he also reap. The deliverance of hell comes to those who allow the process of purification to be completed.

1999 – Pope John Paul:

- Hell was not a physical place! Hell is not punishment imposed by God, but the condition resulting from attitudes and actions which people adopt in this life.
- Hell is the pain, frustration and emptiness of life without God.
